### Crime:

Sexual Battery (Groping) - 243.4(a) PC

### Location/Date/Time:

Tuesday, 11/25/08 at 8:00 pm - Eucalyptus grove between the Student Health and the Facility Club  
Monday, 12/08/08 at 8:45 am – Between Mandler and McGill Halls  
Monday, 12/08/08 at 6:00 pm - Eucalyptus grove between the SunGod and Library Walk

### Suspect description:

Male, unknown race, 19 to 25 years old (one female reported suspect appeared to be an Asian male)  
5'6" to 5'8" tall, 140-150 lbs, described as an average build  
Unknown hair color, unknown facial hair  
Wearing a dark hooded sweatshirt and loose-fitting jeans

### Information:

On Monday, 12/08/08 at about 6pm, a female was walking through the eucalyptus grove between Library Walk and the Sun God, near the Student Health Center. An unknown male approached from behind and grabbed the female's buttock and groin area. The female screamed and turned around to see the male running away.

The female described the suspect as a college-age male with an average build, wearing a dark colored, hooded sweatshirt and loose fitting jeans. He was not seen holding a weapon and did not say anything.

This incident and suspect are similar to a series of sexual battery cases (groping) in the University Town Center area being investigated by the San Diego Police Department. At this time, there is no apparent link between these crimes and the rape that occurred at Mesa Housing on November 7, 2008.

### Update:

After this notification was sent out on 12/09/08, two additional females reported similar incidents that occurred on campus:

On 11/25/08 at about 8 pm, a male grabbed a female's buttock while she was walking from Solis Hall toward the Mandeville bus stop, near Student Health. The male fled again fled on foot. In both incidents, the male matched the description of the listed suspect.

On 12/08/08 at about 8:45 am, a male grabbed a female's buttock with both hands while she was walking between Mandler and McGill Hall. The male ran away and around McGill Hall.

### Safety:
